beliefs

n. feeling of certainty that something exists or is true:

custom

n. way of behaving or a belief which has been established for a long time.

economic

adj. relating to trade, industry and money.

emigrate

v. to leave a country permanently and go to live in another one:

equality

n. right of different groups of people to have a similar social position and receive the same treatment.

ethnic

adj. person belonging to an ethnic group which is very different from those that are common in western culture.

global village n. concept that we are all linked together without barriers of race, religion etc. coined in an era of mass human migration, links by communication, transport and media.

immigrate

v. when someone comes to live in a different country.

nationality

n. the official right to belong to a particular country.

political

adj. relating to politics.

prejudice

n. unfair and unreasonable opinion or feeling, especially when formed without enough thought or knowledge.

respect

n. when you accept that different customs or cultures are different from your own and behave towards them in a way which would not cause offence.

tolerance

n. willingness to accept behaviour and beliefs which are different from your own, although you might not agree with or approve of them.
